Dear Residents, Families, and Friends,

As the country continues to progress through the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, we are continuing to adapt to provide a comfortable environment while attempting to limit the spread of the virus.

As mentioned in our recent communications, we are working on a plan to slowly ease back into a sense of normalcy within our Paramount Senior Living communities. I am pleased to report that beginning next Monday, June 8th, visitation will be initiated at our Peters Township campus.

Visitation will be supervised in a cleaned and controlled environment, which allows ample air flow. For now, visitation will be limited to two family members for a period of 30 minutes and the visitation area will be sanitized after each session. Certain protocols will be required such as temperature monitoring, a screening questionnaire, social distancing of at least 6 feet, and masks; no touching or hugging will be permitted. **This pilot applies only to Personal Care (Assisted Living) residents at our Peters Township campus.**

After a two-week period, we will look to implement these visitation protocols across additional covid-free Paramount Senior Living communities. We are excited about the opportunity for family reunification, but must take a cautious approach, which is why we are starting with one location.
